Background:	TIF $\beta$ (transcription intermediary factor 1-beta) is an 88 kD member of the tripartite motif family. This protein contains three zinc binding domains, a RING domain, a B-box type 1 and type 2 domain, and a coiled-coil region. TIF $\beta$ is found in the nucleus and associates with specific chromatin regions. This protein forms a complex with KRAB-domain transcription factors and recruits setdbl to histone 3 to increase KRAB-mediated transcriptional repression. TIF1 $\beta$ has been reported to interact with setdbl and cbx3 proteins. Studies using knockout mice reveal the important function of TIF1 $\beta$ in regulating genomic imprinting, T cell activation, and T cell tolerance.

HepG2 nuclear extract was resolved by electrophoresis, transferred to nitrocellulose and probed with monoclonal anti-TIF1ß antibody. Proteins were visualized using a goat anti-mouse secondary conjugated to HRP and a chemiluminescence detection system.



HeLa cells were intracellularly stained with 5 ug/ml of purified anti-TIF1β (KAP-1, TRIM28) (clone 20A1) in blocking buffer overnight at 4?, followed by DyLight™ 594 anti-mouse IgG (red) and Alexa Fluor® 488 Phalloidin (green) staining for 20 minutes. Nuclei were counterstained with DAPI (blue). The image was captured with 20X objective.

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
