


HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY DCLRE1B ([RC205744], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-DCLRE1B. Positive lysates [LY411532] (100ug) and [LC411532] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.











HEK293T cells transfected with either [RC205744] overexpress plasmid (Red) or empty vector control plasmid (Blue) were immunostained by anti-DCLRE1B antibody (TA502352), and then analyzed by flow cytometry.
