




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


HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY FCGR1A ([RC207487], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-FCGR1A. Positive lysates [LY400193] (100ug) and [LC400193] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.




Western blot analysis of extracts (10ug) from 4 different cell lines by using anti-FCGR1A monoclonal antibody at 1:200 dilution.




