

Background:	This gene is a member of the methionyl aminopeptidase family and encodes a protein that binds 2 cobalt or manganese ions. This protein functions both by protecting the alpha subunit of eukaryotic initiation factor 2 from inhibitory phosphorylation and by removing the amino-terminal methionine residue from nascent protein. Increased expression of this gene is associated with various forms of cancer and the anti-cancer drugs fumagillin and ovalicin inhibit the protein by irreversibly binding to its active site. A pseudogene of this gene is located on chromosome 2. [provided by RefSeq]




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


HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY METAP2 ([RC203809], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-METAP2. Positive lysates [LY402045] (100ug) and [LC402045] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.




Western blot analysis of extracts (10ug) from 6 different cell lines by using anti-METAP2 monoclonal antibody (1:200).
















