



Background:	IKBKE is a noncanonical I-kappa-B (see MIM 164008) kinase (IKK) that is essential for regulating antiviral signaling pathways. IKBKE has also been identified as a breast cancer (MIM 114480) oncogene and is amplified and overexpressed in over 30% of breast carcinomas and breast cancer cell lines (Hutti et al., 2009 [PubMed 19481526]). HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY IKBKE ([RC212481], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-*IKBKE* (1:500). Positive lysates [LY415533] (100ug) and [LC415533] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.



Immunohistochemical staining of paraffin-embedded Human lung tissue within the normal limits using anti-*IKBKE* mouse monoclonal antibody. (Heat-induced epitope retrieval by 1mM EDTA in 10mM Tris buffer (pH8.5) at 120°C for 3min, TA807631) (1:150)
