






HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY ZNF69 ([RC208624], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-ZNF69 (1:2000). Positive lysates [LY411885] (100ug) and [LC411885] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.
